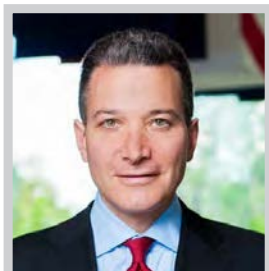

### Topic: “For Debate: Should the Electoral College Be Abolished?”

As the 2020 presidential election approaches, the National Constitution Center in Philadelphia hosts a traveling debate on a question at the center of public discourse: is Electoral College outdated or does it remain a vital aspect of our constitutional republic? Join James Ceaser, professor of politics at the University of Virginia, and Jesse Wegman of the *New York Times* editorial board and author of the new book, *Let the People Pick the President: The Case for Abolishing the Electoral College*, for a debate as old as the U.S. Constitution itself. Jeffrey Rosen, president and CEO of the National Constitution Center, moderates.
